





The Key Largo Conch House is a family business that includes Ted, Laura, Jon, Justin, and Stephanie Dreaver. It was featured on the Food Network in June 2006 as an "off the beaten path" place to dine in Key Largo. Tucked off the highway it's tough to see from the road thanks to the groves of trees and fauna. Set in a quaint, Victorian house in a tropical setting, it boasts a beautiful shaded wrap-around porch for outdoor dining. You can also dine inside and enjoy the underwater DVD.

The Conch House serves breakfast, lunch, and dinner daily, as well as award winning coffee, Lobster Bisque, and Conch Fritters. There's a variety of teas and some of the best homemade desserts on the island. The food has an island flare. Some local favorites include Conch Eggs Benedict, Yellowtail Tacos, Lobster and Conch Ceviche, and Key Lime Almond Hogfish.

It is a pet friendly establishment and is home to Romeo, an African Grey Parrot who entertains on the wrap around porch and Chief, a lovable yellow Lab.

They also cater private parties on and off-site and deliver to local businesses.

Artists of the Month Nadine and Glenn Original Lobster Trap Art

In downtown Tavernier at mile marker 90 there is a little restaurant simply named Craig's where I stopped in for a bite to eat. As I waited for my mouth watering (best I ever had) Reuben sandwich I noticed some interesting artwork on the walls. I asked the waitress, Kitty, about it and she explained that a local couple painted them and made the frames out of old lobster traps.

The artwork on Craig's walls really reflects what the Florida Keys are all about. I was enthralled so I checked out the artists on the Internet.

The artists, Nadine and Glenn, retired from their South Florida nursery business and moved to Lower Matecumbe in 1999.

Three years later the couple took an art course at the local community college. It turned out they were really good at it and soon developed their own distinct style.

To go with their artwork Glenn started recycling old lobster traps from the Florida Keys waters and crafting them into beautiful frames. They are beautiful and unique. No two are alike.

Then in January of 2003 the couple participated in their first art show. It was a success so the pair decided to continue with their work. Softening Judgment Moving Beyond Appearance

It is our natural inclination to judge people, since it happens without our even thinking about it. We take one look and summarize a whole person—overweight, pretty, stylish, sloppy. This habit comes from the mind's need to categorize the world in order to be able to function without becoming overwhelmed. When we judge, we are looking for pertinent information, trying to determine whether the person approaching is a threat, an ally, or someone we don't need to worry about. This way of looking at people makes sense in a dangerous context, but in our daily lives it leads to an overly simplistic reading of the people we meet.

If you have ever judged someone dismissively, only to have them become a dear friend once you got to know them, you know the hazards of the judgment cycle firsthand. An experience like that may have led you to soften your natural tendency to believe your first impressions. We will always notice things about the people we meet, but as we become more conscious

of the shortcomings of judgment, we won't be satisfied with our surface observations. We may notice that someone is driving an expensive car, but we will decide whether to befriend her based on getting to know her over time. We will not rule out a friendship with someone with messy hair, especially if he turns out to have a great sense of humor and a kind heart. Liking or disliking a person is a choice you will naturally make, but it will be after you have gotten to know them.

Next time you notice yourself judging somebody, try to send love, light, or blessings to the person you were judging. Then try to listen to them openly or look them in the eye and learn something about them. If this is not easy for you, remember not to judge yourself either. Trust that with practice, you will successfully disable your habitual patterns. As you do, you will find a whole new dimension of perception opening up to you, allowing you to see beyond the surface and into the essence of the people you meet.

While Breanna works the


