




Ted Hyde has been entertaining the Florida Keys since 1976. Perhaps you remember the duos with Fiddlin Red and Ken Smith. "It's hard to find musicians that compliment each other and it's rare when it's

magical," says Ted.

Ted Hyde Band is no ordinary band. Bob "Bebob" Grabowski plays a weird looking instrument called a Fretless Electric Bass. It is hard to take your eyes off of him. It is mesmerizing! Bebob is the Jazz History Professor at FIU and has entertained at Tobacco Road in Miami for 20 years.

On the drums is Bobby Thomas, Jr. who is world famous and totally amazing. Bobby has played with Weather Report and Jaco Pastorius. "Jaco Pastorius is probably the best bass player that ever lived," says Grateful Ted.

If that's not impressive enough wait till you hear them. Their sound is a blend of rock, blues, jazz and original music in free form jamming technique unique to the Keys. Catch the gig on Sundays from 6 to 10 live at Sharkey's Pub.

The PonTunes fleet is under new ownership and now located next to Marley's Bayside Grill at mile marker 107 under the Jewfish Creek Bridge. For some fun in the sun pick up the phone and call 305-393-5593. My friends and I did and had a fantastic time out on the water. For only \$350 a day (plus gas which was only \$27!) you get all the benefits of a boat without the expense of ownership. To buy one would cost approximately \$30,000, yearly insurance \$1,100, maintenance and upkeep is 25% of the value of the boat per year and storage or boat slip runs from \$250 to \$500 a month. And these PonTune boats are equipped with Sirius radio, GPS, sunshades and giant coolers!

Reservations at PonTunes are a snap, just go to www.pontunes.com and fill out a

short form. The next step is fill up the cooler with ice and snacks, hop on the boat and you're off. Our radio was programmed to the Elvis station and we sang along as we motored around. We were headed to the Buzzard's Roost when the Oceanside got cloudy so we skirted around a marker in the channel that was barely visible under the water. Someone had hit it pretty hard and went back to write "Dammit Gene!" on it. After a libation and refreshing swim at the Big Chill on the bayside we went to explore the "Bogies". The boats are due in at 6:00 p.m. and we barely made it back on time. At the dock we grabbed our gear and headed to Marley's to celebrate a great day. Someone else cleaned the boat and prepped it for the next day. No hassles, no stress.

Take Stock in Children Backcountry Challenge Adds New Category

The Take Stock in Children Backcountry Challenge and Charity Auction scheduled for September 18th through 20th has added an exciting new category. This year there will be a Fly Fishing Division and this division fishing will be strictly on fly with no bait.

The Backcountry Challenge targets the longest snook and redfish. This all-release tournament is unique because fishing starts at 9 pm on Friday after the Captains meeting and doesn't end until 4 pm Sunday. The tournament awards trophies in the Adult category for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in both Snook and Redfish categories, also for Top Guide and Pro-Division. The tournament also features a ladies division, kids division for kids under 14 years old and a Young Angler division (14-17 years). This year the Fly Fishing has been added to the prize categories.

Entry fee for is only \$100 per angler, \$45 for Young Angler and \$40 for socials on or before September 17th and after September 17th there will be an additional fee of \$25 per

angler and social fee will be \$50. All events take place at Sundowners Restaurant in Key Largo and each entry includes a buffet at the Captain's meeting on Friday evening and a fabulous four course dinner on Sunday night during the awards. The tournament also features a silent auction with great merchandise for a fraction of retail prices and raffles.

This charity event is presented by the Rotary Club of Key Largo and is sponsored by TIB, KLI Home Center, FKEC, The Free Press Newspaper, Floridakeys.com and Clearchannel Radio. All proceeds from the tournament will remain in the Upper Keys and will benefit the Take Stock in Children.



Rarely does the Coconut Telegraph have a bartender come as highly recommended as Sandy Asche at Snapper's Tiki Bar.


Annie Leishman, a Snapper's Turtle Club regular was adamant, "Sandy is the best and she has one of the largest followings of all the bartenders I know!"
