In the end, the Proctologists won out, leaving the entire decision up to the assholes in Washington.

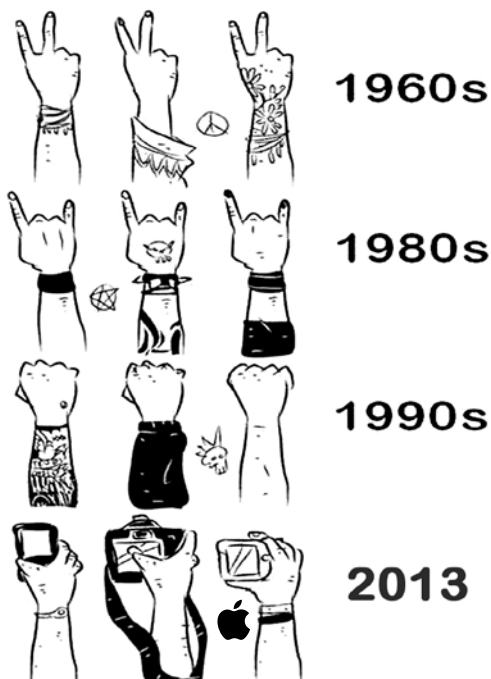
