Bee Population in Decline in the Upper Keys

José Sosa is a Key Largo bee-keeper who has noticed a drastic decline in his honey bee population over the years. He says the Mosquito Control drivers that spray the pesticides are aware of his bees and they stay as far away from them as they can, but when the airplanes fly over and spray he loses thousands of bees each time."



Bee colonies are dwindling across the world. The EPA said in a report that in the USA alone the number of colonies has more than halved since 1947. Scientists believe the loss is likely caused by poor bee nutrition, loss of forage lands, parasites, and exposure to pesticides. Our food supply depends on these pollinators. If honey bees become extinct, so will we humans.

Dr. Geoff Bailey, a Key Largo veterinarian who is running for Mosquito Control believes that genetically modified mosquitos could help the bee population and result in less frequent pesticide spraying. He says...

"Genetically modified mosquitos are males of the

species (which do not bite or spread disease) that have been altered so that they are unable to produce viable offspring. With their continued release into the environment, the natural mosquito population will steadily decline, thus reducing the need for pesticide spraying.

"Additionally, reducing the mosquito population will aid in preventing the spread of certain diseases that are currently threatening the Keys. Dengue Fever has already established a foothold in Key West, and Chikungunya virus will likely soon be here as well, having already invaded the Florida mosquito population just to our north. Any good medical

professional will tell you that prevention is much more desirable than treatment.

"Monroe County is at a crossroads with the way we handle our mosquito control and. We need to start implementing some newer technologies as they become available. Doing so will enable us to attack our mosquito problem more cost effectively, more environmentally friendly, and with a greater degree of success."

Craig describes his art as intricate little shapes and patterns that come together to form a larger image.




Cruising on a sailboat with a two-burner stove is my inspiration for one skillet meals that are still tasty and nutritious. My husband came up with this one for dinner for a night anchored out in Blackwater Sound. There is nothing like a hearty meal under the stars.

Chicken Marsala

- 2 small to medium boneless skinless chicken breasts
- 8 oz. Sliced Baby Bella mushrooms
- 1 can of Golden Mushroom soup
- 1 small thinly sliced onion
- 1 box or bag of frozen peas
- 4 oz Marsala wine
- 4 oz. Light cream or milk
- 1 Tbls of Italian seasonings
- 2 Tbls of garlic (any form that is convenient)
- 2 Tbls butter
- 2 Tbls of cooking oil
- Fresh ground pepper to finish the plate

Slice the chicken breasts into 3/8-inch medallions. Combine the butter and cooking oil in a saute pan and bring to medium high heat. Lightly brown the medallions on both sides and remove from the pan. Reduce the heat and add the sliced onions to the pan. Lightly toast the onions and mix in the can of Golden Mushroom soup. Add the Marsala wine, Italian seasonings, and the garlic and stir together until smooth. Add the sliced mushrooms to the pan, stir and cover until the mixture starts to bubble. Stir in the cream, the peas and return the chicken to the pan. Cover until the mixture starts to bubble again. Check to see if the chicken is cooked to your liking and serve over egg noodles or pasta of your choice.






