


Another Blonde, Another Day

A dozen times the olive eludes her until a man sitting next to her grabs the stick and skewers it for her. "That's the way to do it," he says.


"Big deal," replies the blonde sulkily. "You'd never have gotten it if I hadn't tired it out first."

Stay Updated On Political Correct Terms


How to speak about women and be politically correct:

Silence fell over the congregation.


In the back pew, a little old lady struggled to stand, and finally said in her frail voice, "Rain is also a gift from God, but when we get too much of it, we wear rubbers."
