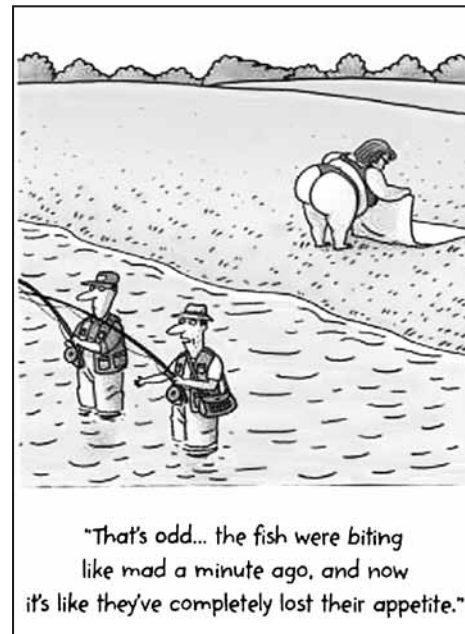

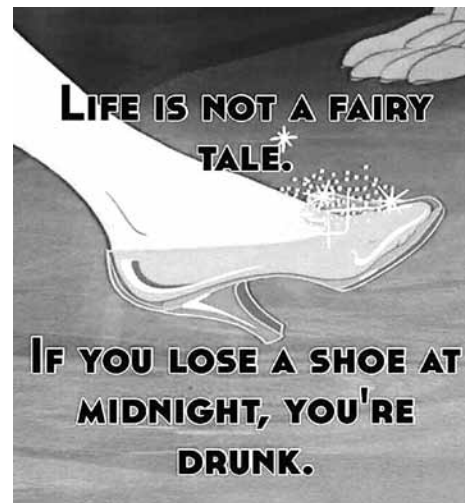
Donald & Daisy

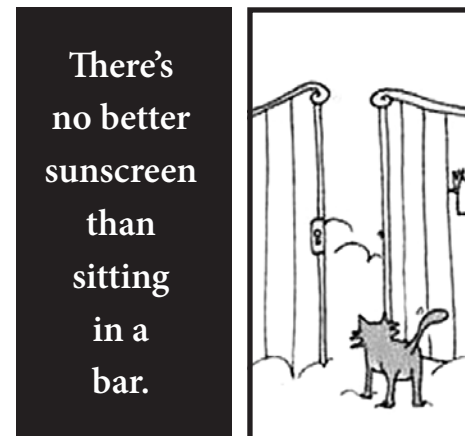
