Ladies, Let's Go Fishing Hosts its LLGF Screamin' Reels Tournament June 22-23, Islamorada, FL

Women, men and teens are invited to a non intimidating LLGF Fishing Screamin' Reels tournament with education June 22-23 in Islamorada, FL. Hosted by the nonprofit Ladies Let's Go Fishing Foundation, the tournament kicks off on Friday with a class on offshore fishing and conservation conducted by Capt. Skip Bradeen, plus an appetizer contest from 6-8 pm at Seaside Glass Works, Islamorada, FL.

Saturday is a day of fishing, learning on the water and friendly angler competition departing from Whale Harbor Marina, Islamorada. Entry to the tournament is currently limited to those choosing the offshore charter boat option, with license and equipment supplied. It is wait-listed for participants fishing from their own boats and from the party boat option.

\$1,000 worth of prizes for individual anglers, including a Penn Squall combo, Penn Passion combo, art prints and other fishing items will be presented on Saturday following fishing. Prizes for inshore and offshore species and releases include Heaviest Fish

Overall, Offshore Billfish Release, Party Boat award, Longest Inshore Fish, Wild Card prizes and more.

This tournament is perfect for novice anglers. Charter boats fill quickly so early registration is encouraged. Registration is \$85 per adult angler, \$35 for teens and includes about \$20 in gifts. Offshore charter fishing rates are on the website.
