## Friday May 18th 7-11pm Igor and Red Elvises

Fresh from a 15-city tour of Canada opening for the Reverend Horton Heat (the godfather of rockabilly and psychobilly), Igor and Red Elvises are bringing their Siberian Surf "Rok 'n' Rol" show to Gilbert's Resort for a one-night only show.

Igor Yuzov was born in Germany, raised in Ukraine and studied in Russia. He grew up in the former Soviet Union, where folk music was the norm and rock 'n' roll was illegal.

A rebellious streak, however, led him to seek out the forbidden music. As soon as it became possible, Igor left Russia for America with his "Folk 'n' Roll" band Limpopo and was personally greeted by Ronald Reagan.

In 1993, Limpopo won Ed McMahon's Star Search and their popularity began to blossom. Evolving over the years, Igor's music has been labeled "Siberian Surf Rock" which contains humorous lyrics and grooves that forces his audience to dance.

For the past few years, Igor has maintained the same core group of talented LA-based musicians known as the Red Elvises. Jasmin Guevara is an immensely talented drummer who will make your jaw drop when she plays her 5-minute drum solo during "Sad Cowboy Song."

Dejah Sandoval is the little lady that plays bass guitar, the huge bass balalaika. (It's bigger than she is!) And she

sings some of the tricky Elvises songs.

Tim Hayn sings, while playing keyboards, trumpet, trombone, the spoons, washboard and any other instrument Igor throws at him.
