"I don't know -- put me down for a five."

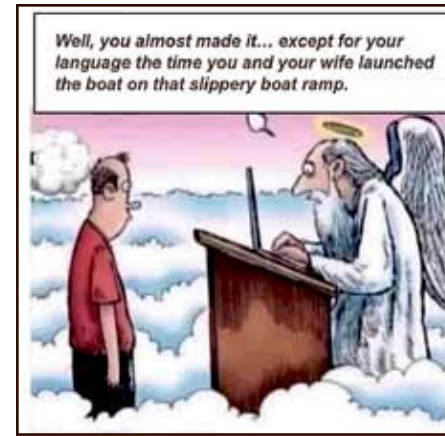

The cardiologist paused, leaned over, and then whispered to the mechanic... "Try doing it with the engine running."

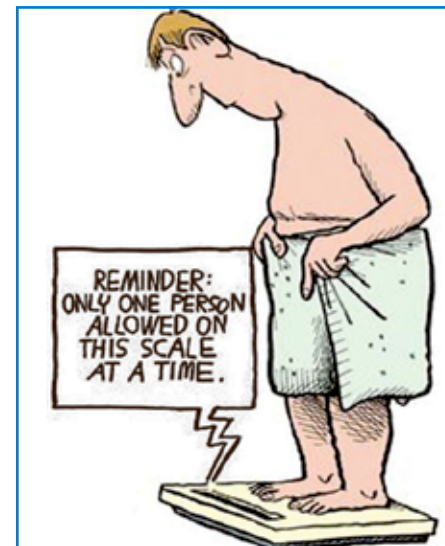

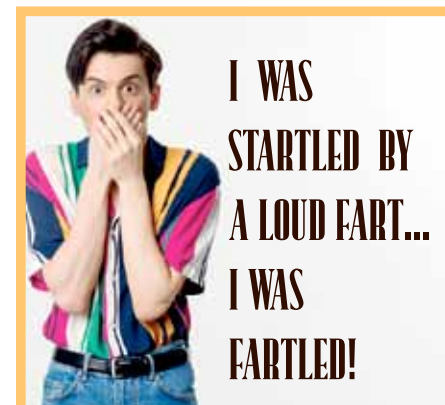

That means, on average, golfers get about 41 miles to the gallon.



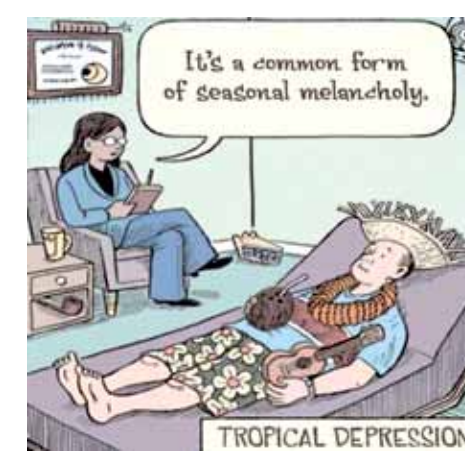
