Bartender: 'What about that eye patch?'

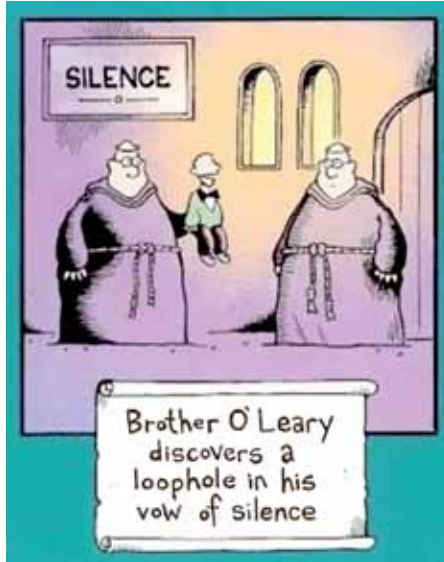
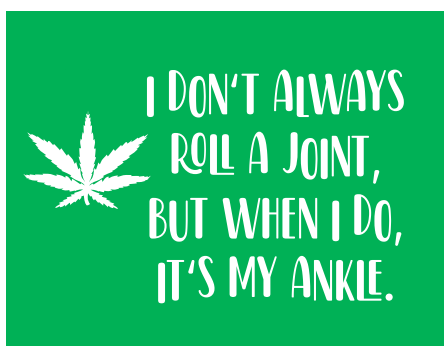
Pirate: 'Oh, one day we were at sea and a flock of birds flew over. I looked up and one of them shit in my eye.'

She agrees. So he fills out the order and asks, "okay, what do you want it to say?"

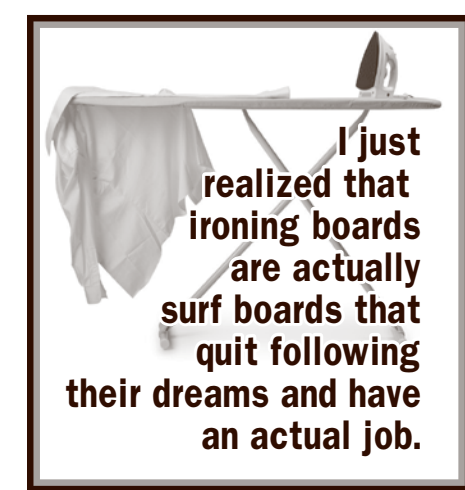
She thinks for a moment and then says: "Dan's dead. Car for sale."

"That's a good question. When you get to 300 feet, you can recognize the faces of people on the ground."

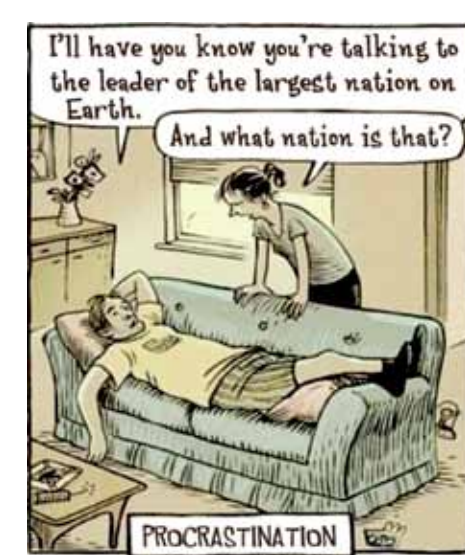
