November Events and Programs at Key Largo Library

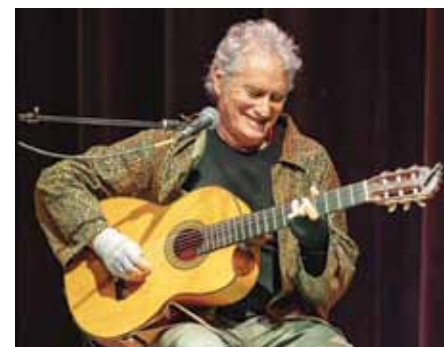
