Artist of the Month: Jeanne Brennan

The Keys Spark Creativity

My first question of Jeanne Brennan was "How does a geophysicist end up in the Keys creating art?" Working in Houston, Texas, Brennan met her husband, JD Carballo, a Miami/Keys native. From 1992 on, they traveled several times a year to the Keys and after retirement in 2020, moved here. Brennan loves the small town feel. "You recognize people in the store or restaurant and can build friendships more easily than in a bigger place. And the sunrises and sunsets are pretty spectacular."

"One of the things that makes life special here is the many Keys non-profits that

contribute to building a better place for us all to live, play and work. These organizations shouldn't be taken for granted."

Jeanne has always loved art, inspired by her mother's pastels, but a serious career was her first objective. In 2003 she started taking night classes at the Houston Museum of Fine Arts. Her skills in photography, watercolor and acrylic grew. When she retired, they blossomed. Natural beauty is her most common creative spark. Every day she finds something new to admire in the beautiful skies and waters of the Keys. This is particularly evident in her photography



of birds and their environment. Brennan is a member of The Art Guild of The Purple Isles (AGPI), an Upper Keys art community that provides opportunities for both new and established artists. There are many art shows during the winter season to showcase the creativity of its members. Classes, a photo group and workshops taught by talented members are available throughout the winter months. The AGPI annual membership fee is very reasonably priced.
