

## 100 Tiny Monumental Paintings by popular local artist John David Hawver

This body of work began as a personal challenge for John Hawver: to create one hundred tiny paintings. Working at such a small scale required him to slow down, simplify, and trust instinct over perfection. Each piece became an exercise in restraint—what to include, what to leave out, and how much feeling can live inside just a few square inches.

Painting small shifts the relationship between the hand, the eye, and the idea. There is very little space for overworking, which makes every mark intentional. The process invites experimentation and play while also demanding focus and discipline. Some paintings were completed quickly, almost visual notes, while others unfolded slowly as he searched for balance within

the limited space.

Taken together, the one hundred paintings function as a visual journal. Each one captures a moment of curiosity, observation, or emotion. Individually they are quiet, intimate objects; collectively they form a larger conversation about the beauty and splendor of our spectacular environment.

John David Hawver's 100 Tiny Monumental Paintings will be exhibited at Our Place in Paradise gallery, 88711 Overseas Highway, in Tavernier. The show runs April 3-30th, with an Opening Reception Saturday, April 11, 5-7 pm.
